Where? Stockholm, Sweden.

When? First workshop: 24-25'th, second: 26-27'th of April 2014. From 09:30 to 17:30 hrs.

What? *First workshop we make our own puppet in the special manner that the Swiss puppeteer and therapist Käthy Wüthrich developed. It is a easy method and also possible to realize with little children from four years of age. These puppets are not made for playing on stage for public but playing symbolic play with. We will feel and reflect the inner process while puppet making and see what a powerful projectionscreen we have in our hands. If the puppet gets ready we will give it a character and will have the opportunity to play with it to become relaxed with having a part of ourselves on our hand.*

The second workshop we will make experiences with specific therapeutic plays and special therapeutic settings. This includes finding stories, realize them on stage with, make experiences in different therapeutic settings, with different age groups and various problems and needs. Also to understand the symbols of the play and respond to them in a symbolic way.
